Wintering example

Here is an example of a wintering box used by a member and kept outside for trees that can tolerate the Wisconsin winter environments.

The box has no bottom and sits in a sand pile; old sheets cover the pots' bonsai soil (below-left), then sand is piled over the pots and serves to insulate pots and roots from cold; the box itself buffers trees from winds; the hinged mesh cover protects from animal feeders (mice, rabbits, deer) and allows snow cover for further insulation and self-watering, and allows easy and ready access as needed (below-right). No fatalities last year!
